Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on March 15, 2016 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. January. Prayer by Mr. Jimmy McClure. The minutes were read by Alderman Etter, Alderman McClure made a motion to accept seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion Passed.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson asked how the Online and Credit Card transaction process was coming along, Leigh Grice stated hopefully it will be up and going by next month.

New Business

1. Community Development Partners sent a Resolution to be passed so the City of Clarksburg can apply for the 2016 Local Parks and Recreation Funds Grant, for the purpose of making improvements within the existing park system. Alderman Etter made a motion to approve Resolution 3-15-16, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
2. Mayor Peterson wanted to recognize Boy Scout Troop 276. Troop 276 cleaned the park and are going to make this part of their community service to keep the park clean. They are also having a Flag Ceremony in the park Monday March 21, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. to replace both the American Flag and the Tennessee State Flag.
3. Alderman Etter made a motion to place an ad in the paper advertising for sealed mowing bids to be sent in by the April 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
4. Alderman Etter made a motion to hire another Certified Police Officer to replace Officer Smith. Alderman McClure seconded. Motion Passed.
5. Mr. Neal Bartholomew wanted to bring to the board's attention the Livestock Zoning Resolution. He was concerned that if for some unavoidable reason he had to remove his livestock from his property because of a natural disaster (tornado) or health related issues that he would not be allowed to move his animals back onto

the property after 30 days. Mayor Peterson, Alderman McClure, and Alderman Etter all agreed that if such an occurrence was to happen that the board would make allowances under the circumstances and the livestock would be permitted back onto the property.

6. Former Alderman Patsy Haywood is in sever critical condition and when the time comes the Flag will fly at half mast.
7. The Financial Report for February was reviewed Alderman McClure made a motion to accept, Alderman Etter seconded. Motion passed.
8. Alderman Etter made a motion to adjourn at 6:25 p.m., Alderman McClure seconded. Motion passed.
