Call to Order

The mayor and aldermen met on Monday, March 17, 2014 at the Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Reed called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The minutes from the February 18 board meeting were read by Terry. Alderman Smith made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. The installation of the linoleum has been completed.
2. Alderman Smith made a motion for Mayor Reed to get an estimate on a fence and gravel for the city's lot across from the Clarksburg Supermarket on Highway 22. This lot can be used to store any seized cars. Mr. King verified this was not in violation of any zoning regulation. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Mayor Reed is to contact Barker Tree Trimming and Davey Tree for estimates on trimming the tree in the parking lot at city hall.
4. Tina Milam was not at the meeting and has not met with Mr. King; therefore, any discussion of the community benevolent fund was tabled until the April meeting.
5. Mayor Reed said Mr. Bartholomew has done the electrical work on the light poles.
6. Mayor Reed asked Mr. O'Brien about the leaf pickup. He reported that the Clarksburg Ruritan Club was meeting at the park Thursday morning (March 20) to begin leaf pickup.
7. Mayor Reed said there had been one stop with the K9 unit.
8. Johnsonville TVA Credit Union came Friday (March 14) and took possession of the car seized in January. The second hearing on the other car is April 8 in Jackson.

New Business

1. Mayor Reed presented the zoning application submitted by Mitch Reed to construct a shop building adjacent to his house. Mayor Reed approved the application.

2. Alderman Smith made a motion to adopt the annual audit report. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Alderman Smith made a motion to accept the financial report for February 2014. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Alderman Smith made a motion to adjourn at 6:20 p.m. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
