Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on April 18, 2016 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Prayer by Mr. Jimmy McClure. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice, Alderman McClure made a motion to accept seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion Passed.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson stated that he had hired Officer Tommy Decanter to replace Officer Smith. Officer Decanter will work the midnight shift and Officer Cupples will move to the second shift position.
2. Mr. Howell Todd and Leigh Grice have been working on the credit card payment system and it has been installed. Citations can now be paid by credit card in the City Hall or online at our website.
3. Two mowing bids were submitted. Pritchard Lawn Service submitted a bid of \$125.00 per mowing and Justin Bolen submitted a bid of \$115.00 per mowing. Alderman Etter made a motion to hire Justin Bolen for the 2016 mowing season upon providing proof of the appropriate insurance. Alderman McClure seconded. Motion passed.

New Business

1. Alderman McClure made a motion to pass the Resolution Adopting Tennessee Model Law Enforcement Policy on Sexually Oriented Crimes. Alderman Etter seconded. Motion passed.
2. Mayor Peterson presented the board with the 2016 LPRF Application for new Playground Equipment that he and Leigh Grice have been working on with Davina Gurschick with Community Development Partners. The information included a power point presentation, along with our Five Year Long Term Plan for the City Park, and the preliminary cost estimate draft. Mayor Peterson also stated that he wanted the

board to consider using some of the money in our property account to help pay the 50/50 match if we receive the grant.

3. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept the Financial Report for March. Alderman McClure seconded. Motion Passed.
4. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:16 p.m. Alderman Etter seconded. Motion passed.
