Call to Order

Old Business

1. Sidewalk Project update. Stokes Surveying has corrected their survey and sent it to the appraiser.

New Business

2. Three (3) bids for the SRTS project were submitted on April 10, 2019.

3. One (1) mowing bid was submitted for the mowing season from Todd's Lawn Care for \$125.00 per cut. Alderman Smith made a motion to accept the bid, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
4. Chief Cole sent a proposal for new Tasers for the Police Dept., to replace the obsolete Tasers we have. Alderman McClure made a motion to replace the tasers, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
5. The Financial Report for March 2019 was reviewed and discussed. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
6. Mayors Report: The sink hole beside Glenn's Automotive has been fixed. Officer Dickey has resigned. Officer Decanter is taking a leave of absence for 5 to 6 weeks. Mayor Todd has an interview with an officer to replace Officer Dickey. The

mandatory utility training for all elected officials is offered through the comptroller's office for free. The training is offered online.
