Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on May 20, 2019 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Todd called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Prayer by Jimmy McClure. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice. Minutes stood approved as read.

Old Business

1. Sidewalk Project update. Nsite Inc., will give a quote for the project. The city and the school will split the cost of the project.
2. A conference will be held Tuesday May 29, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at city hall for the SRTS project.

New Business

1. Davina Gurschick with Community Development Partners, spoke with the board about applying for the Multimodal grant. This grant is a 95 / 5 match. The city would be applying for a sidewalk grant. The sidewalk would run from J&J General Store to Dollar General. Alderman Smith made a motion to begin the pre-application process. Seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
2. Michael King presented the board with a Capitalization Policy. Alderman McClure made a motion to adopt the policy, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
3. The Financial Report for April 2019 was reviewed and discussed. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
4. The amended budget for the 2018-2019FY was reviewed and discussed. Alderman Smith made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-05-20B, amending the budget, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed. (1st Reading)
5. The proposed budget for the 2019-2020FY was reviewed and discussed. Alderman McClure made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-05-20A, for the proposed budget, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed. (1st Reading)
6. Mayors Report: The 2017 LPRF grant audit is done. No findings were found. The mayor would like to consider moving driving school to every other month or

quarterly, depending on attendance. Ricky Scott looked at Chumney Lane and thinks the patches should hold another year. Also, there is a culvert on Purdy Rd that may need to be replaced. The wastewater questionnaire has been sent to Nashville. Pendergrass Ln. will be closed June 3 - June 7, from 5-9 p.m. for Clarksburg Missionary Baptist Church to have VBS.

7. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:40, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
