Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on May 21, 2018 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Prayer by Mr. Jimmy McClure. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson let the board know that he hired Officer Brian Bennett to replace officer Lee Bates.
2. The 2013 police car is back from the body shop, but it will be going to B&E in Jackson to have the lights worked on.

New Business

1. Ms. Kim Carter, City Recorder for the Town on Huntingdon explained how the State of TN mandated that the Town of Huntingdon raise their water and sewer rates, their last rate increase was in 2010. The Mayor asked Ms. Carter to find out how much the City of Clarksburg is paying per gallon for them to treat. Mr. King will check to see if the city has a contract rate already set in place with the Town of Huntingdon.
2. The 1st Reading of the Proposed Budget for the 2018-2019 FY (Ordinance 2018-05-21) was reviewed and discussed. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman McClure motion passed.
3. The City of Clarksburg received an audit proposal from Allen, McGee & Associates LLC, Mr. King advised that the city try to get at least 3 bids by the June meeting before deciding on which firm to use.
4. Mr. Ed Jackson, the regional director for Congressman David Kustoff, wanted to introduce himself and let the board know their office is there if needed.
5. The Financial Report for April 2018 was reviewed. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
6. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:25 p.m., seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
