Call to Order

The mayor and aldermen met on Monday, May 19, 2014 at the Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Reed called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The minutes from the April 21 meeting were read by Terry. Alderman Smith made a motion to accept the minutes. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Mayor Reed read three bids on a new police car:

Helms Motor	-	\$23898 (2014 model)
Swope	-	\$22461 (2013 model)
Ford (State fleet)	-	\$23870 (2014 model)

Alderman Smith made a motion to table the issue until the June meeting. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously. Bid requests must be published in the newspaper. Bids will be opened at the regular June meeting.
2. Mayor Reed reported that we will open the bids on the seized car on Tuesday, June 3, 2014 at 6:00 p.m.
3. Alderman Scates made a motion for Mayor Reed to proceed with getting estimates on erecting a fence and gate near the entrance to the park for storing seized cars. Alderman Smith seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Mayor Reed did not get any estimates on building the Christmas lights to hang on the light poles. He will have estimates at the June 3 meeting.
5. Mayor Reed contacted Road Commissioner Ricky Scott on May 15 to repair the driveways on Haley Street (Slaton and Buttrey residences). He said it would be about 2 weeks before they could complete the repairs.
6. Mayor Reed asked Alderman Smith to contact Danny Simpson about completing the wiring on the light poles to hang the Christmas lights.

## New Business

1. Mayor Reed reported we have two zoning applications. Mr. Marvin Wise (Highway 22) requested to add two rooms onto his house. Sheila Perry requested to have a handicap ramp built on her parent's home on Murphy Lane. Both applications were approved and signed by Mayor Reed.
2. The budget hearing will be Tuesday, June 3, 2014 at 5:45 p.m.
3. Mayor Reed requested that the city approve the city wide yard sale for Saturday, June 21, 2014. Alderman Smith made a motion to approve the yard sale. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion approved unanimously.
4. Alderman Smith made a motion to approve the financial reports for April 2014. Motion seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Alderman Smith made a motion to adjourn at 6:25 p.m. The motion was seconded by Alderman Scates. Motion passed unanimously.
