Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on June 24, 2019 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Todd called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. Prayer by Mayor Todd. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice. Minutes stood approved as read.

Old Business

1. Nsite is scheduled to start SRTS project July 8, 2019, the project is to be completed by October 6, 2019.
2. Nsite submitted a quote of \$14,950.00 for the sidewalk project. This total will be split between to school and the city. Alderman McClure made a motion to proceed, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
3. Mayor Todd let everyone know that him and Mr. Eugene Crum had installed the drop box for City Hall.

6. The proposed budget for the 2019-2020FY was reviewed and discussed. Alderman Smith made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-05-20A, for the proposed budget, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed. (2nd Reading)

New Business

1. The Financial Report for May 2019 was reviewed and discussed. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
2. Mayors Report: Mayor Todd gave an update on the Mr. Theodore Williams property. He is trying to get Mr. Williams connected to the sewer by the end of the month. Mayor Todd has contacted Ms. Glenna Tucker again regarding moving the wrecked car on her property. The city is looking into hosting a fall event in the park to help

raise money for improvements and expansion of the park. Mayor Todd also presented and discussed with the board a building plan for an expansion of City Hall. Mayor Todd also informed the board that Will Woods, a 5th grader at Clarksburg School and also lives in Clarksburg, went to Oklahoma to compete in the 2019 National Beta Club Convention and is now the National Beta Club Social Studies Champion.

3. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 7:10 p.m., seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
