Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on August 26, 2019 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Todd called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Prayer by Mayor Todd. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice. Minutes stood approved as read.

Old Business

1. Mr. Theodore Williams has been contacted by the state and his case has been turned over to the D.A. office, per Ward Pritchard.
2. Clarksburg Utility District decided to leave water bill payments at First Bank.

New Business

1. The Financial Report for July 2019 was reviewed. Alderman McClure made a motion to approve, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
2. Mayor Todd asked Michael King to draft an ordinance making it mandatory to hook to the sewer for any future projects. Mr. King presented the board with an ordinance, he also explained that if the city passes this ordinance that not only future customers will be required to connect to the sewer, but also customers who opted out of connecting in the past. The board decided to table this ordinance for now.
3. Clarksburg School has asked the city to expand the sidewalk project to run from the city hall parking lot to J&J General Store. They would like to split the cost of the project.
4. Mayor Todd informed the board the snowflake lights should ship soon.
5. Mayor Todd let the board know he had approved 2 Zoning Applications.
6. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:33 p.m., seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion passed.
