1. A bid date has been set for the Phase V Sewer expansion. Bids are scheduled to open at 10:00 a.m. on September 20, 2016.

4. Alderman Etter made a motion to re-hire Officer Cary Don Smith, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
5. The Financial Report was reviewed Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the financial report, seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
6. Alderman Etter made a motion to adjourn at 6:33 p.m., seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
