Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on September 18, 2017 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. Prayer by Jimmy McClure. The minutes were read by Leigh Grice. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson gave an update on the LPRF Grant, letting everyone know part of the new playground equipment has been shipped.
2. The 2005 Mercury Sable that was seized in February and sold on GovDeals.com for \$676.00.
3. Mr. Kings office has sent a letter to Mr. Bartholomew regarding the Minimum Sewer Bill. Leigh Grice will look through the storage building to try to find original paperwork for the Phase 1 Sewer Project.

New Business

1. Mr. Tim Joyce with the State of Tennessee presented a 401(k) and a 457 Deferred Compensation Retirement Plan. He explained how this is a voluntary program with no fees or charges and no city match is required.
2. Alderman McClure made a motion to pass a resolution for State of Tennessee Deferred Compensation Plan 401(k), seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
3. Alderman McClure made a motion to pass a resolution for State of Tennessee 457 (b), seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
4. The Financial Report for August was reviewed. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept, seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
5. Mr. Neil Bartholomew wanted to address the vacant property on Purdy Rd by the post office, the property is not being maintained and he asked what the city could do about it? Mayor Peterson and Mr. King both informed Mr. Bartholomew that first the city would have to send a notice to the property owners that the

property is dangerous. Then the city would have to pay for the cleanup, and then set a lien against the property.

6. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:45 p.m., seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
