Call to Order

Mayor Peterson and Alderman McClure met on Tuesday, October 28, 2014. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. A prayer was led by Mr. O'Brien. The minutes were read by Terry. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Mayor Peterson. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson made a motion to keep the 2005 police car, to have the air conditioning repaired and re-install the lights and cage, and have touch up painting completed. Alderman McClure seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Alderman McClure made a motion to table the discussion of a city website until the November meeting when Alderman Etter could present her information. Motion seconded by Mayor Peterson. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Mr. O'Brien presented the board with the park's recommendations for repairing the gazebo and door to the storage building. (Copy is attached.) The estimated cost of all repairs is \$\$5002. Mayor Peterson discussed with Mr. O'Brien about helping to see that the work is done as we requested and done properly. Mr. O'Brien agreed to help. Mayor Peterson made a motion for the town to pay for the repairs. Motion seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Mayor Peterson reported that Mr. King was prepared to file a lien against the Hyatt property located at the corner of Weatherford Street & Highway 22.
5. Mayor Peterson referred to the September minutes about paying \$12,500 to Carroll Bank & Trust in December and the balance in August 2015. This was for street paving done last year.
6. Mayor Peterson reported that we received a notice from the State of Tennessee allowing us to sell the seized 4-wheeler we have had in storage since May 2014. Mr. King reviewed the letter. The "For Sale" notice will be in the Carroll News Leader next Monday and posted around the town.
7. Mayor Peterson reported that he, Mr. Tucker and Terry attended the Safe Route to Schools meeting in September. The plan is to construct sidewalks from Highway 22 to the school area. The state will do an assessment before we apply for the grant.

New Business

1. There are no zoning applications at this time.
2. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the financial report for September 2014. Motion seconded by Mayor Peterson. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Mayor Peterson reported an estimate of \$1000 to repair the cracks in the pavement/parking lot at city hall. A bid of \$4500 was given to repair the cracks and apply a sealer to the pavement. Mayor Peterson made a motion to have the cracks repaired now and have the sealer applied later. Alderman McClure seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Mr. O'Brien stated that there are two new park board members: Natelle Waugh and Judy Smith.
5. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:30 p.m. Motion seconded by Mayor Peterson. Motion passed unanimously.
