Call to Order

The mayor and aldermen met on Monday, November 17, 2014 at the Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. A prayer was led by Mr. McClure. The minutes were read by Terry. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson reported that Mr. King had filed a civil complaint against Jeffrey Hyatt and Stacy Maxwell regarding their property located at 4290 Hwy. 22 in Clarksburg. Mr. King confirmed that a hearing has been set for Tuesday, November 25, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. in General Sessions Court of Carroll County. He stated that Terry would need to attend and bring all statements and correspondence regarding this property.
2. Mayor Peterson reported that Mr. Throgmorton had filed a claim with the State of Tennessee regarding the seizure of his four wheeler. We have not been notified of the court date with the state.
3. Alderman Etter made a motion to proceed with an official website for the town using Option A of the first proposal submitted at the September board meeting. The cost of Option A is \$1375 that includes the license of GovOffice Version 3.3 Content Management System, annual service package, frees stock design template and the start-up package. Alderman McClure seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Mayor Peterson reported that Matthew Cate with the State of Tennessee Safe Route to Schools program will be here Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. to complete an assessment of the school area for possible application for a grant to construct sidewalks from Highway 22 to the school area. Mr. Tucker, from the school, will attend this assessment meeting, too.
5. Mr. O'Brien reported that the lights that shine on the flags in the park are not working. Mark Simpson has ordered the parts needed to repair the lights. Repair work on the gazebo should start within 2-3 weeks, weather permitting. The concrete work will be completed after the other work is completed.

New Business

1. Stanley Scates submitted a zoning application to construct a shed on his property located at 1665 Highway 22. The board reviewed the application and it was approved by Mayor Peterson.
2. Mayor Peterson reported that he had received complaints about “jake brakes” (compression brakes) and the noise they make. Mr. King will research the law and present an ordinance to the board at the December meeting.
3. Alderman McClure made a motion to give City Recorder Terry McCoy a 3% salary increase. Alderman Etter seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept the financial report for October 2014. Alderman McClure seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:25 p.m. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.
