Call to Order

The mayor and aldermen met on Monday, April 20, 2015 at the Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. A prayer was offered by Mr. McClure. The minutes were read by Terry. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson reported he had posted the "use of compression air brakes" signs on Highway 22. The ordinance was also published in the Carroll News Leader.
2. Mr. O'Brien addressed the board concerning the land use ordinance. He asked that they reconsider his request and change the required footage from 300 feet to 100 feet.
3. Alderman Etter made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 03-16-15A (also known as Clarksburg Municipal Code 13-202 (11)). Motion seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Alderman McClure made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance 03-16-15. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Terry reported that the tickets to the Jackson Generals baseball game have been purchased. The game is Saturday, July 11, 2015. The tickets are available for distribution.
6. Mr. King stated he had reviewed the debt policy. He further stated that no changes are necessary at this time.

New Business

1. Mayor Peterson has received a zoning application from Thomas Luther. The application was reviewed, approved and signed by Mayor Peterson.
2. Mayor Peterson stated that the city's property adjacent to Sellers Cemetery is in need of some maintenance. He has obtained an estimate of \$1000 to clean up the wooded area

that centers the property. Alderman Etter made a motion to proceed with the maintenance. Motion seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed unanimously.

3. Mayor Peterson reported that he had obtained an estimate to install a wooden fence and gate on the property we purchased next to the city park. The lot will also need a load of gravel. Alderman McClure made a motion for Mayor Peterson to obtain a second bid. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Alderman Etter made a motion to approve the financial report. Motion seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:16 p.m. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.
