Call to Order

The mayor and aldermen met on Tuesday, February 17, 2015 at the Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. A prayer was led by Mr. Todd. The minutes were read by Terry. Alderman McClure made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Mayor Peterson reported that Barsto Construction has some cleanup work to do, weather permitting. Otherwise, Phase IV of the ongoing sewer project is complete.
2. Mr. Todd updated the board on the status of the website. He has tentatively set Friday, February 20 as the "go live" date. He presented an ordinance concerning the use and privacy policy for the city's website. He asked the board and Mr. King to review the ordinance for passage. He also addressed the webmaster's address, security measures, a counter for number of hits, documents in PDF format, all local businesses on site, and that he did not list the city judge on the site. Mr. Todd also presented a press release about the website and a notice for Facebook. Terry will forward copies of the ordinance, press release and Facebook notice to Mr. King.
3. Mr. O'Brien reported that Dale Autry had completed the painted the gazebo and added vinyl and aluminum to the gazebo. Mark Simpson will begin the electrical repairs weather permitting. Gerald Scarborough plans to wait a few weeks for warmer weather to begin repairing the floor of the gazebo.
4. Mr. O'Brien reported that the park board made \$1844.09 at the pancake breakfast Saturday. That amount is up approximately \$600 from last year. This total was after expenses were paid.
5. Mayor Peterson addressed the animal control ordinance. Suggestions were made to change the footage to 100 feet or 150 feet. The board agreed to delay any decisions until after the public hearing. They also want Mr. King present for any legal questions/advice. A public hearing has been scheduled for Monday, March 16, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. at the city hall.

New Business

1. No zoning applications were issued or received during the month of January.
2. Alderman Etter made a motion to accept the financial report for January 2015. Motion seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed unanimously.

3. Alderman McClure made a motion to adjourn at 6:37 p.m. Motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed unanimously.
