Call to Order

The Mayor and Aldermen met on Monday November 23, 2015 at Clarksburg City Hall. Mayor Peterson called meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Old Business

1. The Financial Report from September 2015 was reviewed and the increase of expenses for the wastewater account explained, Alderman McClure made a motion to accept motion seconded by Alderman Etter. Motion passed.
2. Standing date for the Annual City Wide Yard Sale was set to be held the first Saturday in June.
3. Mayor Peterson and Leigh Grice had a phone conference on November 12, 2015 about the Sewer Grant. The grant is still in the environmental phase, hopeful for construction on begin late next year. Also the discussion on responsibility of maintenance is still being looked into. Attorney Michael King suggested that we look into setting up an understanding with the Town of Huntingdon about maintenance. He also stated we should start setting aside money for future repairs, and set up a sewer use and maintenance policy for the city.
4. Mr. Todd asked about hiring a full time Public Works/Sewer employee and both Mayor Peterson and Attorney King said that at this time that was not an option.

New Business

1. Donations from the City were reviewed and Alderman Etter made a motion we remove the Christmas Angels (\$300) from donations and put back in general fund, second by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.
2. Mayor Peterson asked everyone to consider hiring another police officer for the midnight shift, just wants everyone to think on this for now.
3. Financial Report for October was reviewed Alderman Etter made a motion to accept seconded by Alderman McClure. Motion passed.

4. Alderman McClure made motion to adjourn at 6:26 p.m. motion seconded by Alderman Etter.
